

## Board of Governors' Dental Scholarship-Loan Program (BGDSL) Contact Information

The Board of Governors' Dental Scholarship-Loan Program (BGDSL) provides financial support for North Carolinians studying dentistry at the Dental School at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill.

The program replaces the Board of Governors' Dental Scholarship Program for new dental students after July 1, 2005, and is now offered as a scholarship-loan program to recipients. Recipients are required to repay the awards by working as licensed dentists in North Carolina following graduation. Students who do not repay through service are obligated to repay in cash at an annual interest rate of 10%.

Students will receive \$5,000 plus tuition, mandatory fees, medical insurance, a laptop computer and required dental equipment. If funding proves to be insufficient, these amounts will be prorated. Awards are renewable annually for a total award period of four years, provided the student makes satisfactory academic progress, continues to have financial need, and remains interested in dental practice in North Carolina.
