

## Board of Governors' Medical Scholarship-Loan Program (BGMSL) Contact Information

The Board of Governors' Medical Scholarship-Loan Program (BGMSL) provides financial support for North Carolinians studying medicine at Duke University School of Medicine, Brody School of Medicine at East Carolina University, the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill School of Medicine, or Wake Forest University School of Medicine.

The program replaces the Board of Governors' Medical Scholarship Program for new medical students after July 1, 2005, and is now offered as a scholarship-loan program to recipients. Recipients are required to repay the awards by working as licensed medical doctors in North Carolina following graduation. Students who do not repay through service are obligated to repay in cash at an annual interest rate of 10%.

Students will receive \$5,000 plus tuition, mandatory fees, mandatory medical insurance, and, for the first year of the program, a laptop computer. If funding proves to be insufficient, these amounts will be prorated. Awards are renewable annually for a total award period of four years, provided the student makes satisfactory academic progress, continues to have financial need, and remains interested in medical practice in North Carolina upon graduation.
