New Applicants

The FTNC program has closed its application process for the 2007-2008 academic year.

Current undergraduate students pursuing degrees that lead to teacher licensure in **math, science, special education, and English as a second language** may apply for the FTNC for the 2008-09. [FTNC Applications](#) are submitted to the applicant's School/department of Education and evaluated by the dean of the School/department of Education. Applicants selected as nominees are submitted to the SEAA by the dean/chair of the School/department of Education for evaluation. Consideration for the 2008-09 FTNC scholarship loan will remain open for new nominees until funds have been exhausted.

- **Please note that students who are current recipients of the Prospective Teacher Scholarship Loan, the Physical Education - Coaching Scholarship/Loan or the Teaching Fellows Program are not eligible to apply for the FTNC program.**

Current Recipients

Please visit the Student Portal at www.cfnc.org/seaastudent to submit your electronic renewal for the Future Teachers of North Carolina Scholarship Loan (FTNC) for the 2008-2009 academic year. Access to the Student Portal may be obtained by using your CFNC username and password. **Current recipients may now apply for renewal for the 2008-09 academic year at the above link. As a reminder, a student can only receive two years of FTNC funding.**

Graduates

If you have graduated, send an official transcript that shows the awarded degree and date of graduation and a [Request for Cancellation through Service form](#) in order to cancel the loan through service as a teacher in the state of North Carolina. Graduating recipients may also contact the Repayment Services department to obtain a Repayment Agreement to repay their loan monetarily. Those who have received the maximum amount of funding but have not finished their studies and are carrying 12 credit hours per semester may submit a [Request for Postponement of Payment](#) and an [Enrollment Status Verification Form](#).
