### APPLICANT QUESTIONS:

- Q1. How can I apply for a McLendon Scholarship?
- Recipients are selected by their colleges. For more information about the application process, contact the college you plan to attend.
- Q2. What are the eligibility requirements?
- A student must meet the following eligibility requirements:
- Be North Carolina resident for tuition purposes
  - Be varsity athlete at participating campus
- Q3. Is there a deadline for applying?
- An applicant should contact the campus he/she is planning to attend for all the scholarship requirements and application procedures, including deadlines.
- Q4. What is the value of the scholarship?
- Recipients will be awarded \$1,250 per academic year.
- Q5. May I apply if I plan to attend an institution other than one of the listed eligible institutions?
- No. Applicants must attend one of the eligible institutions.
- Q6. Is the scholarship renewable?
- The scholarship is not renewable; however, the participating institution may award the scholarship to a recipient for another year.
