**All Applicants and Recipients: Email is the official form of communication between the Nurse Educators of Tomorrow Program and the applicant. It is strongly recommended that applicants and recipients keep their contact information up to date on the SEAA Student Portal.**

## Graduates

If you have graduated, send an official transcript that shows the awarded degree and date of graduation and a [Request for Cancellation through Service form](#) to cancel their loan through serving the state of North Carolina as a nurse educator. Graduating recipients may also contact the Repayment Services department to obtain a Repayment Agreement to repay their loan monetarily. Those who have received the maximum amount of funding but have not finished their studies and are carrying 9 credit hours per semester may submit a [Request for Postponement of Payment](#) and an [Enrollment Status Verification Form](#).
