New Applicants

Due to the repeal of this program by the 2011 North Carolina General Assembly, the 2011-12 academic year was the last year for which new recipients were selected. Current recipients will be renewed if eligible; however, beginning with the 2012-13 academic year, new applicants must apply for funding through the Forgivable Education Loans for Service Program (FELS). FELS program details are available at CFNC.org/FELS.

Current Recipients

The renewal period for your scholarship loan program will begin in May 2012; however, recipients that are enrolled in year round programs need to submit official transcripts reflecting that 18 semester hours have been earned for the 2011-12 academic year as soon as possible.

NET awards are **not** automatically renewed; recipients must complete the renewal process in **Spring 2012** before being deemed eligible for continued award funding.

Email is the official form of communication between the Nurse Educators of Tomorrow Scholarship Loan Program and the applicant. It is the responsibility of the applicant and/or recipient to remain informed about the information contained in the SEAA Student Portal, and to keep their contact information up to date.

Graduates

If you have graduated, send an official transcript that shows the awarded degree and date of graduation and a [Request for Cancellation through Service form](#) to cancel your loan through serving the state of North Carolina as a nurse. Graduating recipients may also contact the Repayment Services department to obtain a Repayment Agreement to repay their loan monetarily. Those who have received the maximum amount of funding but have not finished their studies and are carrying 9 credit hours per semester may submit a [Request for Postponement of Payment](#) and an [Enrollment Status Verification Form](#).
