New Applicants

The Nurse Scholars Program funding decision for **BSN** is now available online. Applicants should check their funding status through the [Student Portal](#) on the [CFNC.org](#) website. You may obtain access to the Student Portal by using your CFNC user name and password.

The application deadlines for the **2008-2009** academic year are as follows:

Deadline has expired	Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN)
May 3, 2008	Associate Degree in Nursing (ADN)
	Masters Degree in Nursing (MSN)

The NSP application for **ADN** and **MSN** may be accessed by completing the scholarship application tool ([the Scholarship Wizard](#)). The application data will be submitted electronically through the Scholarship Wizard.

All supporting documentation to the application (transcripts, reference forms, etc.) must be postmarked by the respective date listed above. Applicants may confirm that application documents have been received online through the [Student Portal](#) on the CFNC.org webpage. **Please allow one week for processing before calling to follow up on documents marked as “Not Received” on Student Portal.** As a reminder, funding is not available for summer sessions.

Graduates

If you have graduated, send an official transcript that shows the awarded degree and date of graduation. Also submit a [Request for Cancellation through Service form](#) to cancel your loan through service as a licensed Registered Nurse in the state of North Carolina. Graduating recipients may also contact the Repayment Services department to obtain a Repayment Agreement to repay their loan monetarily. Those who have received the maximum amount of funding but have not finished their studies and are carrying 12 credit hours per semester may submit a [Request for Postponement of Payment](#) and an [Enrollment Status Verification Form](#).
