

PEC Current Announcements

New Applicants

The PEC program has re-opened its application process for the 2007-2008 academic year. Current undergraduate students pursuing degrees that lead to teacher licensure may apply for the PEC for the 2007-08 academic year. [PEC Applications](#) are submitted to the applicant's School/department of Education and evaluated by the dean of the School/department of Education. Applicants selected as nominees are submitted to the SEAA by the dean/chair of the School/department of Education, for evaluation. Consideration for the 2007-08 PEC scholarship loan will remain open for new nominees until funds have been exhausted.

- ◆ **Please note that students who are current recipients of the Prospective Teacher Scholarship Loan, Future Teachers of North Carolina Scholarship/Loan or the Teaching Fellows Program are not eligible to apply for the PEC program.**

Current Recipients

Spring funding will be disbursed by SEAA to the colleges and universities in mid-December. Recipients may not see this credit reflected on their accounts until the first day of classes, depending on the policies of their institution. Spring funding is not contingent upon fall grades; please do not send in a transcript at the end of your fall semester. **Current recipients will be able to renew for the 2008-09 academic year in April 2008.** Additional renewal information will be posted as that time approaches.

Graduates

If you have graduated, send an official transcript that shows the awarded degree and date of graduation and a [Request for Cancellation through Service form](#) to cancel their loan through serving the state of North Carolina as a teacher. Graduating recipients may also contact the Repayment Services department to obtain a Repayment Agreement to repay their loan monetarily. Those who have received the maximum amount of funding but have not finished their studies and are carrying 12 credit hours per semester may submit a [Request for Postponement of Payment](#) and an [Enrollment Status Verification Form](#).
