

TASF Current Announcements

Extension- The deadline for submitting TASF "new" and "renewal" for 2007-08 applications has been extended until June 1st. If you are a new or renewal applicant, please submit the appropriate application and all requested information as soon as possible.

TASL Graduates - Congratulations!!!! If you were a previous TASL recipient, upon graduation, inform TASF, in writing, of your choice to cancel your loan with service in North Carolina or to repay your loan through cash repayment. We must receive this notification within 90 days of your graduation date. Award Process - Award recipients are selected based on grade point average and financial need. Because TASF is a state funded program, funds cannot be released prior to legislative approval. For applicants receiving awards, an award letter will be mailed with instructions for the award packet completion. Please read the letter carefully and complete and return the award packet according to the instructions. Incomplete packets will **NOT** be accepted. Funds are sent to the applicant's college by electronic funds transfer around the beginning of the semester. The funds will be held by the applicant's college for deposit in an account maintained by the college. Financial aid departments must process the funds as well, and by policy, funds are not available before the first day of the semester.

Results for TASF Applicants – All applicants, whether awarded or not, receive a letter by postal mail indicating the results of their applications. Due to the privacy act, we cannot release award information by phone or email, so please wait for notification by postal mail.

Application Deadline – **The TASF priority deadline is March 31st each academic year. This year, the application period for 2007-08 has been re-opened and the deadline has been extended until June 1st. If interested, please forward all supportive documents as designated in the application instructions.** The 2007-08 application is located at www.cfnc.org/tasf .
