Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.		
What?	 The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include: Social Security number and payment history income and account balances credit history and employment information When you are <i>no longer</i> our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice. 		
How?	All financial companies need to share nonpublic personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their nonpublic personal information; the reasons NCSEAA chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

How does NCSEAA protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.	
How does NCSEAA collect my personal information?	 We collect your personal information, for example, when you apply for a loan or provide employment information pay your bills or give us your contact information give us your income information We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates or other companies. 	
Why can't I limit all sharing?	Federal law gives you the right to limit only

Definitions Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be	
	 financial and nonfinancial companies. North Carolina State Education Assistance Authority has no affiliates. 	
Nonaffiliates	 Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. North Carolina State Education Assistance Authority does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you. 	
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.
