Documentation of Disability



Updating the Documentation of a Disability

Does your student need to update the documentation of a disability?

- 1. Find your student's current Eligibility Determination Form.

 For a description of the form, see our website. On the last page of the form there should be a list of people who attended the meeting, their signatures, and the date.
- 2. Find the date of the meeting in the "Date" column and add three to the year.
- 3. If the meeting date was 2020: 2020 + 3 = 2023

TIP: If your student's Eligibility Determination meeting date is 2020...

Start the process to update in the fall of 2023!





Options for Renewing ESA+ students

NC Public School IEP Process

The only acceptable documentation of a disability for **new students**

Required in order to **update the area of disability** (in order to change the award level)

Required to update if student's only area of disability is Developmental Delay

Continuing Eligibility Form

An option for students who are already in the ESA+ Scholarship Program (& who do *not* need to update the area of disability)

Not an option for students whose only area of disability is Developmental Delay

Award Levels



ESA+ Award Amounts

Base Amount: \$9,000 per academic year.

- \$4,500 disbursed in Fall
- \$4,500 disbursed in Spring

Higher Amount: \$17,000 per academic year

- \$8,500 disbursed in Fall
- \$8,500 disbursed in Spring

Disabilities are listed on Eligibility Determination Form





ESA+ Higher Award

These areas of disability may qualify the student for the higher award amount of \$17,000. Terms listed as they appear on the Eligibility Determination.

- Autism
- Hearing Impairment,
 Deafness, Deaf-Blindness
- Intellectual Disability,
 Moderate or Severe
- Orthopedic Impairment
- Visual Impairment

Program Eligibility Requirements





Do ESA+ funds roll over to next school year?

- Students who receive a \$9,000 award may not accumulate any funds in the ESA+ account year over year. Remaining funds do not roll over to the next year.
- Students who receive a \$17,000 award may roll over a maximum of \$4,500 from the current year remaining funds and may roll over previously accumulated funds.
 - The overall maximum account limit is \$30,000.

Remaining ESA+ funds for *all* students roll over from *fall* semester to *spring* semester.



Developmental Delay



Developmental Delay: to update the documentation of a disability

- Students with Developmental Delay as the only area of disability must be reevaluated by a North Carolina public school
- Parents can request this evaluation without re-enrolling back in public school
- This updated documentation of a disability is due 3 years after the date on file.





How to Update Area of Disability



Process & Timeline

1. Parent pursues public school re-evaluation process

Once the updated Eligibility Determination is in hand ...

- 2. Parent emails ESA+ to ask for a link to upload document
- 3. Depending on the timing, a parent may have to wait to upload

ESA+ can only update the award level to the higher amount at certain points in the scholarship cycle.





How to Upload a Document to MyPortal

- 1. Sign on to MyPortal.
- 2. Look for the To Do list.
- 3. Look for the task with the link: "Continuing Eligibility Information".
- 4. Submit the document as ONE Word or PDF file.

Tip: Don't email your document. Staff will only have to ask you to upload to MyPortal.







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IMPORTANT ESA+ REMINDERS

Parents should check MyPortal once a week:

- Are there items on the To Do list?
- Look at Notifications. Maybe you've missed an email!

ESA+ students need updated documentation of a disability every 3 years (3 years from the evaluation date on file).

HOWEVER: Parents, you will renew annually so that the ESA+ staff know you want your student to continue next year.

ESA+ is **not a reimbursement** program.

- Very few exceptions (mainly the ESA+ Reimbursement Schools)
- Do not purchase items or pay for services with the intent to submit a receipt.

Public School? If a student will be in the public school, full-time, as normally assigned, then they are **not eligible for ESA+**.

ESA+ is not permitted to provide funds to students who are enrolled in their regular public school (including charter schools).
