## **Attention: Home School Families**



#### **School Changes**

Home school families have until October 1, 2023, to change their school choice from a home school to a direct payment school. After October 1<sup>St</sup>, families will need to wait until the beginning of spring semester to make a change.

# **Direct Payment Schools: Did You Know?**

Certification and Endorsement for school payments is a three-step process that must be completed in the order listed below. Once these steps are complete, we can release funds to your school, and if additional funds remain, funds then are sent to ClassWallet.

- **Step 1:** Direct Payment School certifies student (confirms they are enrolled & provides cost information to SEAA)
- **Step 2:** Direct Payment School endorses scholarship amount (confirms student is attending the school)
- **Step 3:** Parent endorses scholarship amount (confirms that the amount to be paid is correct)

Schools must certify and endorse first, before parents can endorse!
