# **School Changes**



Home school families have until March 1, 2024, to change their school choice from a home school to a direct payment school for the spring 2024 semester (email <a href="ESA@ncseaa.edu">ESA@ncseaa.edu</a>). Parents can change enrollment in MyPortal themselves for the 2024-2025 school year through the summer. For more information visit <a href="School Transfers">School Transfers</a> on our website.

#### **Updated Documentation of a Disability**

If your student's eligibility determination is outdated (dated 2020), you must submit a new document by March 1, 2024 to remain in the ESA+ program.

If new documentation is not submitted by March 1<sup>st</sup>, spring funds will be forfeited, any renewal submitted will become invalid, and your student will be unable to continue in the program the next school year.
